

Collective confusion results in grateful donation

The Gippsland Cancer Care Centre recently received a welcome boost with a \$500 donation from the Willow Grove and District Lions Club.

The Gippsland Cancer Care Centre was the grateful recipient of the donation, which came about after the Club collected 378kg of ring-pulls from aluminium cans.

The Club was at a loss as to how to dispose of the ring-pulls after it was discovered they were actually made from aluminium, not titanium, which they believed could have been melted down and made into prosthetic limbs.

Local recycler Arthur Cunningham offered the Willow Grove and District Lions Club a fair price for the ring-pulls and the proceeds were donated to the Gippsland Cancer Care Centre.
